New London, CT— The Winter months are here! Quarter number two is closing on January 13, 2023. What does all this mean? Students will be looking at their grades, families will be asking questions on how to help with grades and check in on their child. So how do you do this? PowerSchool!

The question is, what exactly is PowerSchool? ISAAC utilizes PowerSchool as its student information system. The PowerSchool Public Portal provides parents and students online access to student attendance and grades through the Internet. The PowerSchool Mobile App is available to download on Apple iOS or Android mobile devices for quick access to student information as well. Having PowerSchool helps families monitor UpToDate student work and grades including attendance. In addition, ISAAC only prints the 4th Quarter report card. All other report card need to be reviewed through PowerSchool.

Parents/Caregivers can log on to PowerSchool using their mobile app. Or by visiting the ISAAC website at <https://isaacschool.powerschool.com/>. Parents are encouraged to contact the main office for help with setting up an account at 860-447-1003.
