ISAAC is able to provide many of these wonderful opportunities as part of the 21st Century Community Learning Centers Grant (21CCLC). The school is currently in the second year of their five year 21CCLC grant cycle. The five year grant and the additional Enhancement Grant ISAAC was awarded last spring totals 1.2 million dollars to be used for after school programming and family engagement.

During the 2022-2023 school year, ISAAC plans on hosting two more of the Dance and Dine experiences. In addition, ISAAC will be providing families of 21CCLC after school programming participants the opportunity to receive a family style meal each month. ISAAC will be sending surveys over the course of the year to gauge interest in what our families would like to have as an opportunity for parents and their families.
